

### **Abundant Generosity**

I imagine that by the time you read this reflection, you will have read or heard that this year's Stewardship theme is Rooted in Abundance. The theme is derived from the book of the prophet Jeremiah in reference to those who trust in the Lord as opposed to those who "trust in mere humans, who rely on human strength and turn their hearts away from the Lord." (Jer. 17:6) The prophet Jeremiah says that:

But blessed are those who trust in the Lord and have made the Lord their hope and confidence. They are like trees planted along a riverbank, with roots that reach deep into the water. Such trees are not bothered by the heat or worried by long months of drought. Their leaves stay green, and they never stop producing fruit. (Jeremiah 17:7-8).

As I like to say, there is nothing so beautiful as seeing the scriptures fulfilled in our own eyes. The events of the past month, right here at Holy Trinity, once again, demonstrated the abundant generosity of our people that is rooted in awareness and appreciation of the abundant gifts of time, talent and treasure, that God has entrusted to us. Praise God for the opportunity we have, to keep up the good work of inviting, welcoming, and connecting people to God and one another; and providing a warm, welcoming, and Christcentered community to belong, blossom, and bless.

### **Vestry Meeting Highlights**

October, 2023

The Vestry met for their monthly meeting on **Thursday, October 19, 2023** to discuss matters of importance to the life and mission of our church.

- 1. The Vestry reviewed and approved the September Vestry meeting minutes as amended.
- 2. The Junior Warden reported that:

a. New siding for the school building has been completed; while the needed siding for parts of the parish House will be completed by the end of October.

b. The repair on the damaged classroom roof has been completed, while the walls and carpet are scheduled to be completed by the end of October.

- 3. The Vestry voted to approve the upgrade of the church's security system and install a new system for the school.
- 4. The Vestry was reminded of the upcoming events which include:
  - a. November 19<sup>th</sup> Consecration Sunday
  - b. Donations for the cost of shipping Operation Christmas Child boxes
  - c. Donations for Wreaths Across America for the Veteran's in our cemetery.
- 5, Fr. Samuel informed the Vestry that:
  - a. Ms. Carole-lynn Petronella has begun her duties as Interim Head of School.
  - b. Nominations are open to fill 3 positions each for a 3-yr. term on the Vestry; beginning January 2024.
  - c. The Ministry Fair, Blessing of the animals, and Episcopal School Celebration went very well.
  - d. Preparations for the Annual School Golf Benefit were in full swing and looking forward to a successful event.
  - e. The Vestry voted to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. It was noted that even though the September income was below budget, both the year to-date the income and expenses remain within budget.
- **5.** The Vestry voted to appoint Jeannette Rodenbaugh as Assistant Treasurer with special responsibility for school finances.
